ENTRY GATE(S) / REMOTE CONTROLS / KEYPAD INFORMATION / INPUT FORM

The following information is provided primarily to facilitate new residents to the sub-division regarding the proper use of the entry gate(s), keypad, remote controls, etc. The entry gate(s) are OPEN to facilitate the normal daytime egress of the homeowner(s), family, friends, mail/delivery/repair/services, etc. The gate(s) are also equipped to AUTOMATICALLY OPEN when Police/Firemen/Emergency Medical Personnel approach. The gate operators are seasonally adjusted to CLOSE after dark. (PLEASE NOTE: EVEN THOUGH THE ENTRY GATES PROVIDE A CERTAIN SENSE OF SAFETY --- THERE FUNCTION CAN NOT BE CONSIDERED "TOTAL SECURITY" FOR OUR RESIDENTS AND/OR THEIR PROPERTIES!!!)

REMOTE CONTROL(S)

The remote controls for the operation of the entry gate(s) can be secured by contacting any of the HHHA Board Members to obtain the name of the person(s) who are currently the responsible Gatekeeper(s)/Coordinator(s). If you are purchasing a "pre-owned" home/property you may have received remote control(s) from the previous owner that are in workable condition. In the event that you have an inoperable remote control and/or you want to purchase additional remote control(s) please contact either of the current Coordinator(s) for information/assistance.

KEYPAD FUNCTION(S)

The Keypad is located on the right side of the roadway (hard surface pull-over area) just outside the Entry Gate(s) upon exiting Jefferson-Paige Road on Lakeside Drive. The Keypad provides TWO (2) FUNCTIONS:

(1)---a listing of Residents, which is OPTIONAL -- some Residents may choose NOT to be listed. Family/Friends /Visitors may access the sub-division by scrolling down the names listed and pressing the "Call Button" with your name selected on the Keypad. When YOU answer their call (to either your residential "landline" or cell phone number) YOU provide them access approval by pressing the number "9" on YOUR phone/cell which then signals the operators to open the gate(s). (NOTE: YOU MAY ALSO USE THIS METHOD TO OPEN THE GATE(S) IF YOUR REMOTE IS TEMPORARILY INOPERABLE!!! -- ASSUMING SOMEONE IS AT HOME OR AVAILABLE BY CELL PHONE). At this time, the Keypad will ONLY function with a local -- 318 area code -- no long-distance numbers are programmable by the system hardware.

(2)---YOU (or persons YOU AUTHORIZE -- PLEASE CONSIDER SECURITY ISSUES -- AND LIMIT THOSE YOU PROVIDE THIS ACCESS CODE TOO) may open the Entry Gate(s) by pressing the number/pound sign (#) and inputting the PERSONAL/PRIVATE four (4) digit access code number you choose and list below.
